

Careers Ambassador (Teacher) – Job Description

The main duties of a Careers Ambassador (Teacher) are as follows:

General

- act as an advocate for the transformative power of Careers education
- attend relevant meetings where Careers training, guidance or support is offered

Curriculum Responsibilities

- act as the SPoC (single point of contact) within a curriculum/faculty area for Careers education
- support curriculum area Careers content development
- support Careers across the curriculum audits
- support the organisation of curriculum specific speakers or visitors
- ensure curriculum area Careers display board is up-to-date and well presented.

Pastoral

- attend, when required or on a rotational basis, parent consultation evening
- support the organisation of curriculum specific speakers or visitors
- support staff CPD which has Careers focus
- on a rotational basis, support with main Careers display board
